

HIGHLAND PARK SPRING CLEAN UP DAYS

The City's Annual Spring Clean-up Program will be conducted by VEOLIA ES, LLC, on four consecutive Saturdays beginning May 1 2010. This year, collection will again coincide with residents' primary garbage collection day (the primary collection day is the day when both garbage and recycling are collected).

Oversized Items

Veolia ES, LLC will pick up all oversized items that are placed at the curb before 7am, on residents scheduled Saturday. If discarding wastes from a do-it-yourself project, make sure material is bundled so that one person can pick it up and place it in the truck. Carpeting must be rolled, and should not exceed the weight that one person can carry. Waste material generated by a general contractor will not be accepted.

In order to keep City streets clean, please **do not place any material out for collection earlier than one week before your scheduled collection.**

The following items are ***NOT*** accepted for spring collection: regular garbage; yardwaste: debris from landscapers, tree trimmers, or contractors: demolition material from fences, roofs, or exterior building debris: rubber tires: batteries: and oil and household hazardous wastes, such as paint, pesticides, or pool chemicals.

Appliances

Residents with appliances (such as: refrigerators/freezers (please remove doors); stoves; dishwashers; washers/dryers; furnaces/boilers; hot water heaters; air conditioners; and microwave ovens) for collection must call a special number at 1-800-480-4337. Veolia ES, LLC. will not collect these items. When calling, please indicate your name, address, and the type of item to be collected. Once you call, your item will be picked up on the following Spring Clean-Up Saturday, free of charge. When scheduling an appliance pick-up, it does not have to coincide with your Saturday when regular bulk items will be collected.

Please note: Residents must bring the item to the curb in order for it to be collected.
